



RULES GOVERNING SHORT TERM GUEST AND CLANDESTINE HOSTS

In accordance with Article 9 of the resident's contract and Article 4 of the Rules and Usages of the Cité Universitaire the following is decreed;

1. Lodging of external hosts

Primarily for security reasons and for Police requirements lodging a clandestine guest is against the rules of the Cité Universitaire.

2. Definition

Any person, who is in a lodgement of the Cité Universitaire between 11.30pm and 07.00am with neither a contract nor having been declared at the reception, is a clandestine guest.

3. Reception of external guests

3.1. The reception of an external guest in a lodging occupied by a resident is possible under the following conditions;

- a. Upon declaration at the reception and filling the police formalities (Register of Arrival).
- b. The limit of the stay is 2 weeks in a single room.
The limit of the stay is one month in a studio with chambrette/s in Building B or an apartment in Building C.
- c. Payment of the tax of CHF 13.- per night.

3.2. The reception of an external guest in a lodging (single, studio or apartment) occupied by a resident, by a member of family of the resident is possible under the following conditions;

- a. The stay must not exceed 3 months.
- b. The dues must be acquitted for the stay in conformation of the rules and tariffs in vigour at the Cité Universitaire

3.3. The reception of more than one external guest or a guest who wishes to stay longer than the allowed length figuring in the points 3.1 and 3.2 are subject to a individual authorisation from the management.

4. Sanctions

Lodging a clandestine guest can be grounds for terminating the resident's contract.
